Fort Wilderness: Boat, Bus, Golf Cart

EPCOT / Hollywood Studios Area

BoardWalk Inn & Villas: Walk, Boat, Bus,
Skyliner (via EPCOT)
Yacht Club: Walk, Boat, Bus, Skyliner (via
EPCOT)
Beach Club: Walk, Boat, Bus, Skyliner (via
EPCOT)

Animal Kingdom Area

Animal Kingdom Lodge (Jambo & Kidani):
Bus Only
Pixie Dust Tip: Closest to Animal Kingdom
but still requires bus transportation.

Caribbean Beach: Skyliner Hub, Bus
Riviera Resort: Skyliner, Bus
Art of Animation: Skyliner, Bus
Pop Century: Skyliner, Bus
Coronado Springs: Bus Only (No Skyliner)

Value & Moderate Resorts

All-Star Movies: Bus Only
All-Star Music: Bus Only
All-Star Sports: Bus Only

Disney Springs Area

Port Orleans – Riverside: Boat, Bus
Port Orleans – French Quarter: Boat, Bus
Old Key West: Boat, Bus
Saratoga Springs: Walk (10 min), Boat,
Bus

Transportation Hours

Buses: 45 min before park opens → 1 hr
after close
Skyliner: 1 hr before earliest park opens
→ 1.5 hrs after latest closes
Monorail: 30 min before park opens → 1
hr after close
Ferryboats: Similar hours to Monorail

Other Transportation Options

Minnie Vans (Lyft): On-demand
rides anywhere on Disney property.
Ride Share (Uber/Lyft): Available at
all parks and resorts.
Driving: Free parking for Disney
resort guests; \$30/day for off-site
guests.
Ferryboats: Sail from TTC or Magic
Kingdom-area resorts.
Monorail: Connects Magic Kingdom,
EPCOT, and nearby resorts.
Skyliner: Connects EPCOT,
Hollywood Studios, and Skyliner
resorts.
